Lost and Found Vocabulary

1. **direction:** lines or paths along which someone or something goes, lies, or points.
2. **rumpled:** wrinkled or creased
3. **situations:** sets of conditions at certain moments in time
4. **unusual:** not usual, common, or ordinary
5. **visible:** able to be seen
6. **worried:** concerned or anxious
7. **furious:** really angry
8. **examined:** looked at or studied carefully
9. **fez:** a cone shaped hat with a flat top
10. **plunged:** fell quickly and suddenly

Math Vocabulary

- **Place Value**—the value of a digit based on its position in a number. *For example, in the number 9,456, four is in the hundreds place and has a value of 400.*
- **Standard Form**—a way of writing a number as a sum of the values of its digits.
Example: 9,456
- **Expanded Form**—a way of writing numbers using the digits 0-9 with each digit having a place value
Example: 9,000 + 400 + 50 + 6
- **Word Form**—a way of writing numbers using words
Example: nine thousand, four hundred fifty-six
