## Math Vocabulary

- Place Value-the value of a digit based on its position in a number. For example, in the number 9,456, four is in the hundreds place and has a value of 400 .
- Standard Form-a way of writing a number as a sum of the values of its digits.
Example: 9,456
- Expanded Form-a way of writing numbers using the digits 0-9 with each digit having a place value Example: 9,000 + 400 + $50+6$
- Word Form-a way of writing numbers using words Example: nine thousand, four hundred fifty-six
