Vocabulary: Using Context

There are three keys for unlocking word meaning from context:



Key 1 Watch for a word or phrase that defines an unfamiliar word.

A gentle wind carried the delicious smell far away from Mousopolis, into the **distance**.

Key 2 Watch for a word or phrase that gives a clear meaning of an unfamiliar word.

Dogzilla was an **ancient** creature, perhaps millions of years old.

Key 3 If no single word gives a clue, look at the whole sentence for clues to the meaning of an unfamiliar word.

Mice from all corners of the community had come together to **compete** in the First Annual Barbecue Cook-Off.
