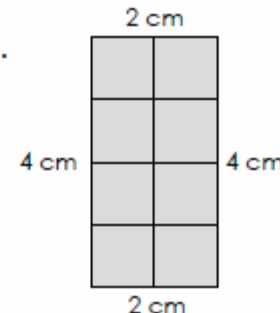

Area and Perimeter

- We are studying area and perimeter in Math.
- Area is the measurement inside an object.
 $A = length \times width$
- Perimeter is the measurement around an object.
- Study the examples in your math journal.
- Area/Perimeter Test on October 19th.**

Perimeter is the distance around a shape. To find the perimeter, add the length of each side.

Area is the number of square units that can fit inside of a shape. To find the area, count the square units.



Perimeter = 12 cm
Area = 8 cm²
