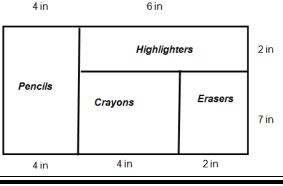

## **School Supply Box Area**

- The area of pencil section is 36 sq. inches, because  $4 \times 9 = 36$ . •
- The area of highligter section is 12 sq. in., because  $6 \times 2 = 12$ .
- The area of eraser section is 14 sq. inches, because  $2 \times 7 = 14$ .
- The area of crayon section is 28 sq. inches, because  $4 \times 7 = 28$ .
- The area of the entire school supply box is 90 sq. inches, because  $9 \times 10 = 90$ .
